Funded by Create NSW, we are widely recognised as leading on best practice in touring. Our core service is working with producing companies based in NSW and presenting venues nationally to develop and deliver a diverse range of tours

across genres. Our program also includes events and initiatives that build touring capacity across the sector, broaden the reach of professional work to smaller and more remote towns in NSW, and maximise the impact of touring productions in the communities we work with.

By working collaboratively with our producer and presenter partners and across the sector as a whole, our vision is for every community in Australia to have a creative pulse, made stronger by the arts experiences we bring.

Welcome to Salon

Welcome! We're very excited to be here with you at our fourth Salon. Salon emerged out of a sector-identified need for makers and presenters from across NSW and the ACT to get together. We think of it as a meeting place — to start conversations and to spark our imaginations — informal and relaxed, but with some structure to help you find whatever it is you're looking for.

If you've been before, you'll notice this Salon has a little more breathing room. We have responded to your feedback and given the event more time, and three distinct parts. First there's the (somewhat) fast and furious formal pitch part, where both makers and presenters take their turn at the mic. Then there's the less formal but still facilitated 'place at the table' part, where you get to sit down and have a (brief) one-on-one conversation. And finally you'll arrive at the totally unstructured part, where you get to continue your conversations over a drink.

For this Salon we had an overwhelming number of applications to pitch, and it's incredibly inspiring to see how much great work is being made regionally and in our cities across NSW and the ACT. Choosing who gets to pitch is about presenting a range of work that's being made – it's only a small slice of the great work that's on offer. Which is why you have this book!

Last year we presented our first regional Salon, in Bathurst, to coincide with Regional Arts NSW's Artstate. We focussed on regionally-made work, and it was a hit. So, we're doing it again this year in Tamworth, and we hope to see you there.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

AIR is a black comedy about death, grief, holding on and letting go. Annabel (Eloise Snape) sits in a dark radio studio, hosting the graveyard shift. Single and introverted, she spends her nights reading the death notices to a silent audience. One morning while on air, the station phone rings. When Annabel answers, she unwittingly unleashes the grief and secrets of an entire community, desperate to connect with the past. The inspiration for AIR came from Erskine's own experiences with grief, and a small notice in the SMH obituaries about a radio service that reads the death notices daily (2RPH).



ABOUT THE PROJECT

Freefall is an important new play by one of Sydney's most exciting emerging writers – Emily Dash. Led by two strong feminist protagonists, it is a unique exploration of our desire for connection – to ourselves, others and the world. Freefall asks: how do we love someone who sees the world so differently? —how can love withstand the pressure, when we are rocked to our core? —and how do perceptions of ability impact on how we see the world?
